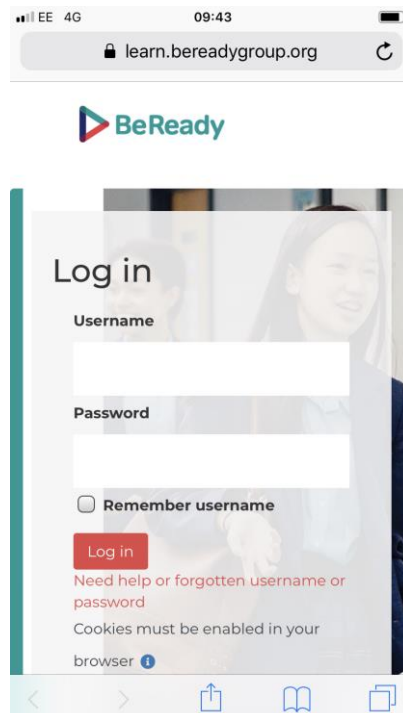
Dear Students,

When you complete the three tasks which form the lesson, a wheel will show your progress. **This can be viewed by your teachers who can see if you have completed the starter quiz, listened to the lesson and completed the exit ticket.** This will help us to see your progress. Your teachers love hearing from you by email, so if you have a question, or there is a task which you are stuck with, feel free to contact them. They will try to respond within 48 hours. You could even just send them an email to let them know how you are doing!

I know your Heads of Year have also been emailing you regularly, and love it when you reply to their messages. Please also keep sending them excellent examples of the distance learning you've been producing at home. They love seeing your work from your different subjects, and may well ask you if you'd mind us sharing particularly impressive work on the school website and Facebook page!
